

Duration: 07 Nights / 08 Days

Itinerary:

Day 01: Delhi:

Meet on arrival at Delhi Airport and transfer to Hotel. Relax and overnight.

Day 02: Delhi / Shimla

Morning breakfast checkout and drive to Shimla - the land of pine scented hills, beautiful peaks, crisp winter skies, fragrant cedar forests, romantic mists and golden hillsides. On arrival check into your hotel. Overnight.

Day 03: Shimla / Kufri Valley / Shimla:

Morning breakfast drive to Kufri Valley - located 16 kms from Shimla, it commands a panoramic view of the majestic Himalayas. Rest of the day free to explore Shimla's famous Mall Road. Overnight.

Day 04: Shimla / Manali:

Early breakfast checkout and proceed to Manali enroute visit Pandoh Dam, Beas river, Sutlaj River, Beas Sutlaj Link Project, Kullu Valley and Dassehra Maidan. On arrival check into your hotel. Relax and overnight.

Day 05: Manali - Rohtang Pass - Manali:

Morning breakfast, proceed for an excursion to Rohtang Pass, located 51 km from Manali, 3978

meters high, which for centuries was the gateway to the trading routes that led to Lahaul, Ladakh and Central Asia. From the crest of the pass, one can take in a sweeping panorama of Mountain Ranges, Pinnacles, precipitous cliffs, ridges, huge glaciers, moraine and deep ravines. Back to hotel. Overnight.

Day 06: Manali

Morning breakfast, visit the Jagatsukh Naggar Art Gallery, Hadimba Devi Temple and the

Tibetan Monastery before proceeding to Vashisht village, just outside Manali, across the river Beas, known for its hot sulphur springs whose water is said to have curative properties. Back to hotel. Rest of the day free. Overnight.

Day 07: Manali / Chandigarh

Early breakfast checkout and proceed to Chandigarh. Enroute visit Rock Garden, Rose Garden and Pinjore Garden. On arrival check into Hotel. Overnight.

Day 08: Chandigarh / Delhi

Breakfast checkout and drive to Delhi. On arrival drop to Delhi Airport to board the flight for onward destination. Tour Ends.

Yes, Australian passport holders require a visa to enter India for tourism, business, medical, or other purposes

e-Tourist Visa (Most Common): Valid for tourism, sightseeing, short-term yoga programs, and visiting friends/relatives.

Validity options: - 30 days (double entry), 1 year (multiple entry), 5 years (multiple entry)

Stay limit: 90 days per visit

e-Business Visa

For attending meetings, business discussions, or exhibitions Valid for 1 year (multiple entries), 180 days stay per visa

e-Medical Visa

For short-term medical treatment in India Valid for 60 days with triple entry

How to Apply:

- Apply online via the official Indian government portal: https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/evisa/
- No physical visit required, Upload passport scan and photograph, Payment is made online, Approval typically within 3–5 working days

Documents Required:

- Valid Australian passport (minimum 6 months validity from date of arrival)
- Recent passport-size photograph (as per specs)
- Copy of return/onward flight ticket may be asked
- Additional documentation for business or medical visas

Booking Terms:

- Deposit of 25% of the package cost at the time of booking.
- Need 50% payment of the package cost, 60 days prior to departure date
- Need 100% payment of the package cost, 30 days prior to departure date
