

Golden Triangle & Karnataka



Duration: 13 Nights / 14 Days

Itinerary:

Day 01: Delhi:

Meet on arrival at Delhi Airport and transfer to Hotel. Relax and overnight.

Day 02: Delhi:

Morning breakfast proceed for full day local sightseeing visit tour of Old & New Delhi. Old Delhi - An ancient walled city. Visit Red Fort (visit subject to security permission), the most opulent Fort and Palace of the Mughal Empire, Raj Ghat, the memorial site of the Mahatma Gandhi, Jama Masjid - the largest mosque in India and Chandini Chowk, the bustling and colourful market of the old city. New Delhi - This city designed and built by the British in the 1920's - a city of wide boulevards impressive Government buildings, green parks and gardens. Visit Humayun's Tomb, Qutub Minar, India Gate and Parliament House. Overnight.

Day 03: Delhi / Agra:

Morning breakfast checkout and drive to Agra. On arrival check into Hotel. Later proceed to visit Taj Mahal - Built by Shah Jahan, the Taj is a white marble memorial to his beautiful wife Mumtaz Mahal. This monument took 22 years to be completed and was designed, and planned by Persian architect Ustad Isa, Agra Fort - Built by the famed Mughal emperor Akbar in 1565 AD, the fort is predominantly of red sandstone. Ensclosed within is the picture perfect Pearl Mosque, which is a major tourist attraction. Overnight. (Taj Mahal remains closed on every Friday)

Day 04: Agra / Jaipur:

Morning after breakfast checkout and drive to Jaipur, enroute visit Fatehpur Sikri - The deserted red Sandstone City, Emperor Akbar built that as his capital and palace in the late 16th century is an exhilarating experience. It a veritable fairytale city and its "ruins" are in pristine condition. On arrival at Jaipur check into Hotel. Relax and overnight.

Day 05: Jaipur:

Morning breakfast proceed for sightseeing visit Hawa Mahal - The ornamental facade of this " Palace of Winds " is a prominent landmark in Jaipur. It is a five-storey structure of sandstone plastered pink encrusted with fine trelliswork and elaborate balconies, and Jantar Mantar Observatory - This is the largest and the best preserved of the five observatories built by Jai Singh II in different parts of the country, Jaigarh Fort – which was mainly utilized as the defence system against the invaders. Back to hotel. Overnight.

Day 06: Jaipur:

Morning breakfast proceed to visit the dramatic hilltop fortress at Amber – ascend the imposing fort on a painted elephant. Back to hotel. Evening free for shopping. Overnight.

Day 07: Jaipur / Bangalore: (By Flight)

Morning after breakfast checkout and drive to Jaipur Airport to board the flight to Bangalore.

Meet on arrival at Bangalore Airport and transfer to Hotel. Depending upon the arrival time proceed for half day sightseeing visit ISKCON temple - the Krishna Temple is a blend of Modern technology and spiritual harmony, Lalbagh - 240 acres of beautifully sculpted gardens, flowers abound, rare collection of tropical and sub-tropical plants, Vidhana Soudha - this massive building houses the state Legislature and the Secretariat. Return to hotel and overnight.

Day 08: Bangalore / Mysore:

Morning breakfast, checkout and proceed to Mysore, enroute visit Srirangapatna. On arrival, check in to a hotel. After lunch relax and later on in the evening visit Chamundi Hill - perched a top a hill-the 4.8m tall monolith of Nandi and the gigantic Mahishasura statue are added attractions. Return to hotel and overnight.

Day 09: Mysore:

Morning breakfast and proceed for full day sight seeing, visit Maharaja Palace - the palace is a splendid structure in the Indo-Saracenic Style, among its many attractions are a magnificent gold throne, Art Gallery - the art gallery in the Jaganmohan Palace houses an excellent collection of ceramics, sandalwood, ivory, stone, antique furniture and ancient musical instruments, St. Philomena's Church - this imposing Gothic structure with beautiful stained glass windows and lofty towers is a must see. Later on in the evening visit Brindavan Garden - the Krishna Raja Sagar Dam after sundown, when musical fountains and colored lights transform this place into a magical fairyland. Return to hotel and overnight.

Day 10: Mysore/ Nagarahole National Park – Kabini:

Morning breakfast, check out and proceed to drive to - Kabini - Nestled in the southern fringes of the Nagarahole National Park, it is a perfect getaway for nature lovers. The breathtaking locale with the tranquil backwaters of the River Kabini presents an ideal setting for a long-

awaited vacation. Check in on arrival and proceed for buffet lunch. Wildlife safari in the evening. Wildlife Film followed by camp fire and buffet dinner. Overnight.

Day 11: Nagarahole National Park – Kabini:

Morning wake up at 05:45hrs to get ready for Bird watching, Boat ride and Wildlife safari. Return to lodge at around 09:00hrs for breakfast. Relax or take a walk around the backwater area. Evening Safari, Dinner and overnight.

Day 12: Nagarahole National Park –Kabini / Hassan

Morning Jeep safari or boating, breakfast, check out and proceed to Hassan, on arrival check into a hotel. After lunch visit Belur - The most photographed and perhaps the best and it is a must on every tourist's temple itinerary, Halebid - the temple, perched on a star-shaped base amidst lawns, is a sculptural extravaganza. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 13: Hassan / Bangalore

Morning breakfast, checkout and proceed to Bangalore, enroute visit Shravanabelagola - The monolithic statue of Lord Gomateshwara, a Jain saint and an object of worship for centuries, standing atop one of the hills. On arrival check into hotel. Overnight.

Day 14: Bangalore:

Morning after breakfast check out and drive to Bangalore Airport to board the flight for Onward destination. Tour Ends.

India Visa Guidelines:

Yes, Australian passport holders **require a visa** to enter India for tourism, business, medical, or other purposes

e-Tourist Visa (Most Common): Valid for tourism, sightseeing, short-term yoga programs, and visiting friends/relatives.

Validity options: - 30 days (double entry), 1 year (multiple entry), 5 years (multiple entry)

Stay limit: 90 days per visit

e-Business Visa

For attending meetings, business discussions, or exhibitions

Valid for 1 year (multiple entries), 180 days stay per visa

e-Medical Visa

For short-term medical treatment in India

Valid for 60 days with triple entry

How to Apply:

- No physical visit required, Upload passport scan and photograph, Payment is made online, Approval typically within 3–5 working days

Documents Required:

- Valid Australian passport (minimum 6 months validity from date of arrival)
- Recent passport-size photograph (as per specs)
- Copy of return/onward flight ticket may be asked
- Additional documentation for business or medical visas

Booking Terms:

- Deposit of 25% of the package cost at the time of booking.
- Need 50% payment of the package cost, 60 days prior to departure date
- Need 100% payment of the package cost, 30 days prior to departure date
